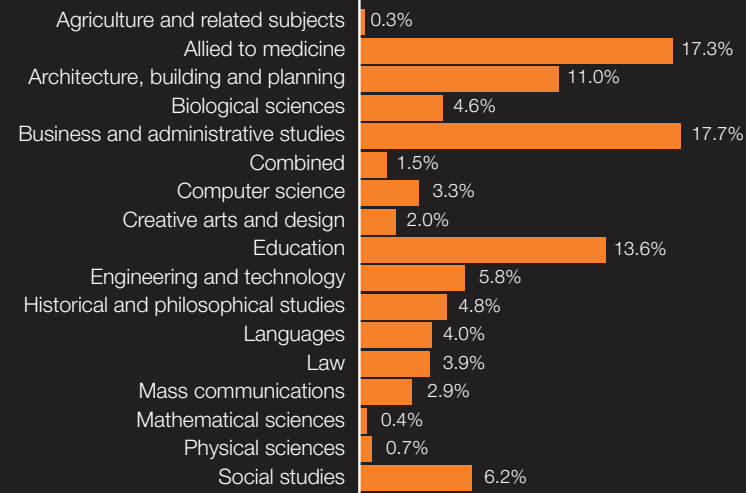

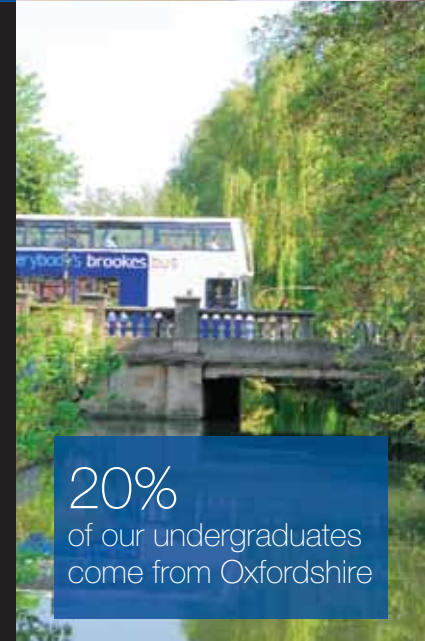

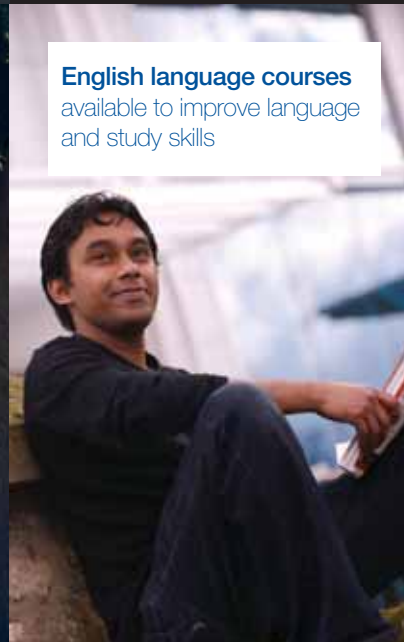


The Government's 2008 Research Assessment Exercise showed more than three quarters of our research activity is of 'international standing'

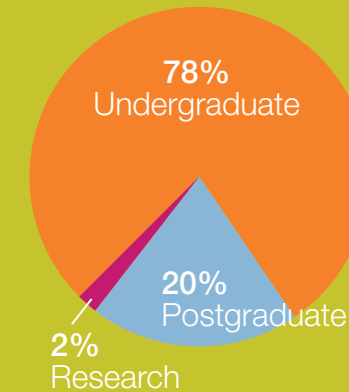

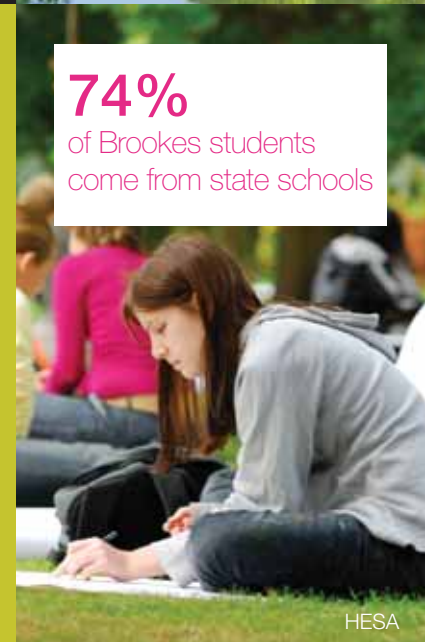
English language courses available to improve language and study skills

Brookes has gained recognition as an **Investor in People** (IIP standard) – focusing on improving organisational performance through its people, by managing and developing them according to best practice.

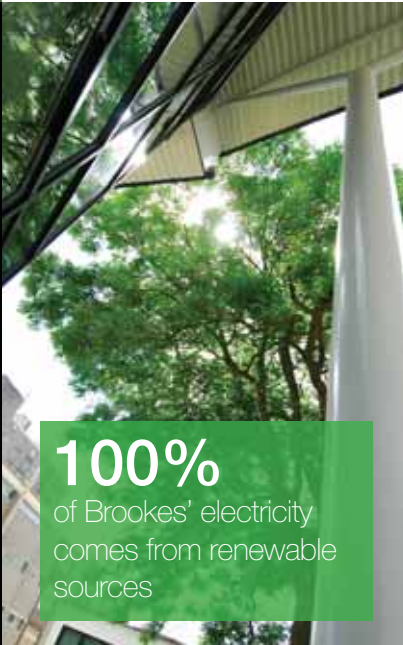
