THE POLITICAL FUNDS

UNISON's **Affiliated Political Fund (APF)** is used to campaign for and promote UNISON policy and the need for quality public services within the Labour Party, locally and nationally, in Parliament and Europe. UNISON APF affiliates to the Labour Party.

UNISON's **General Political Fund (GPF)** is used to pay for campaigning at branch, regional and national levels of the union and for research and lobbying in Parliament and Europe. It is independent of support for any political party.

It is important that you indicate a choice of fund by ticking at least one of the boxes below left. Your subscription shown above includes a political fund payment so you do not pay any more by being in one of the funds. If you wish to belong to both funds, tick both boxes - this will cost an extra 3% of your subscription.

THE BRANCH WELFARE FUND

The branch Welfare Fund, to which many members make voluntary donations (typically 50p per month), provides fruit, flowers or a gift for OBU members who are away from work due to a long illness. It can also provide financial assistance in cases of hardship.
