Fee-Waiver Scholarships Available

Applications are open for three Departmental scholarships available for our MA courses. They apply to students intending to start their course in September 2018.

One scholarship is available to an **international student** who is intending to study on either the MA International Relations or the MA International Security. This will be worth the value of home/EU student fees (£6,120) with the remaining balance of £8,160 to be paid by the scholarship holder themselves.

One fee-waiver scholarship is available to a **home/EU student** who is intending to study on either the MA International Relations or the MA International Security. This will cover 100% of the tuition fees (£6,120).

One fee-waiver scholarship is available to a student who is intending to study on the **MA International Relations (Distance Learning)**. This will cover 100% of the tuition fees (£6,120).

Applicants for all scholarships will need to hold an offer before submitting their scholarship application form. The deadline is 4 May 2018.
