MA International Relations (Distance Learning)

Applications are now open for **two** School of Social Sciences scholarships available for applicants to our MA International Relations, MA International Security and MA International Relations (Distance Learning) courses. The details of the two scholarships are as follows:

The scholarship competition is open to any of the following:

1. An international student who is intending to study on either the MA International Relations or MA International Security. This will be worth the value of home student fees (£7,850) with the remaining balance of £7,850 to be paid by the scholarship holder themselves. This is open to students intending to start their course in September 2022.
2. A home student who is intending to study on either the MA International Relations or MA International Security. This will cover 100% of the tuition fees (£7,850) and is open to full-time or part-time students intending to start their course in September 2022.
3. A student who is intending to study on the MA International Relations (Distance Learning). This will cover 100% of the tuition fees (£7,850) and is open to full-time or part-time students intending to start their course in September 2022.

Please note these scholarships do not cover the living costs of studying in Oxford on the MA International Relations and MA International Security. Guidelines on how much you should expect to spend on your living costs can be found [here](#).

Applicants for all scholarships will need to hold an offer before submitting their scholarship application form.

This trip enables students to get a first-hand experience of how these important international institutions work.
