Brief Overview

The MBA Senior Leader Degree Apprenticeship is an intensive and demanding course designed for the rising stars in your organisation who need to fit studying into their busy working lifestyle. The Oxford Brookes Global MBA will broaden their knowledge and encourage it to be applied in a range of situations. Delivered by an experienced team of tutors, this degree apprenticeship will prepare participants to meet the challenges of the increasingly dynamic international business environment.

Who is it for?

Organisations looking to develop aspiring and existing leaders and professionals and strengthen their strategic capabilities.

Learning outcomes

- The Oxford Brookes Global MBA
- Eligibility for CMI and ILM member status
- Strategic leadership and management skills, knowledge and behaviours.

Entry requirements

- A good undergraduate degree or GPA equivalent
- Three years' relevant managerial or professional experience, or seven years without a degree
- English and Maths Level 2, equivalent to GCSE grade C or 4 or above
- Managerial support for 20% off-the-job training.

Modules and teaching overview

The course typically runs for 36 months. Apprentices spend at least 20% of their time on off-the-job training studying both online and on-campus and attending two residential workshops. Progress in the workplace will be monitored through regular contact between the employer, apprentice and tutors.

Apprentices complete

- In-class orientation (Apprenticeship)
- Oxford Brookes Global MBA Programme – including completion of a work-based project on a strategic issue
- A portfolio of evidence demonstrating key skills, knowledge and behaviours expected of a senior leader
- End Point Assessment (EPA).

Compulsory modules covered

- Market and Supply Analysis
- Entrepreneurial Behaviours and Practices
- Accounting and Finance for Managers
- Developing Leadership Capability
- Global Business Environment
- Global Strategy for Innovation
- Critical Approach to Business
- Individual Consultancy Project
- Personal and Professional Development (not credited)

Participants will also choose two elective modules. Please note that whilst a minimum of four modules (plus two residential workshops) must be studied in class, it is possible to study the remainder of the programme online, subject to module availability.

End Point Assessment

The End Point Assessment must demonstrate the apprentice has the knowledge, skills and behaviours expected of a senior leader, and consists of 2 distinct assessment methods:

- Project showcase based on a work-based project, including report, presentation and questioning
- Professional discussion based on a portfolio review.
