We had 195 formal academic appeals

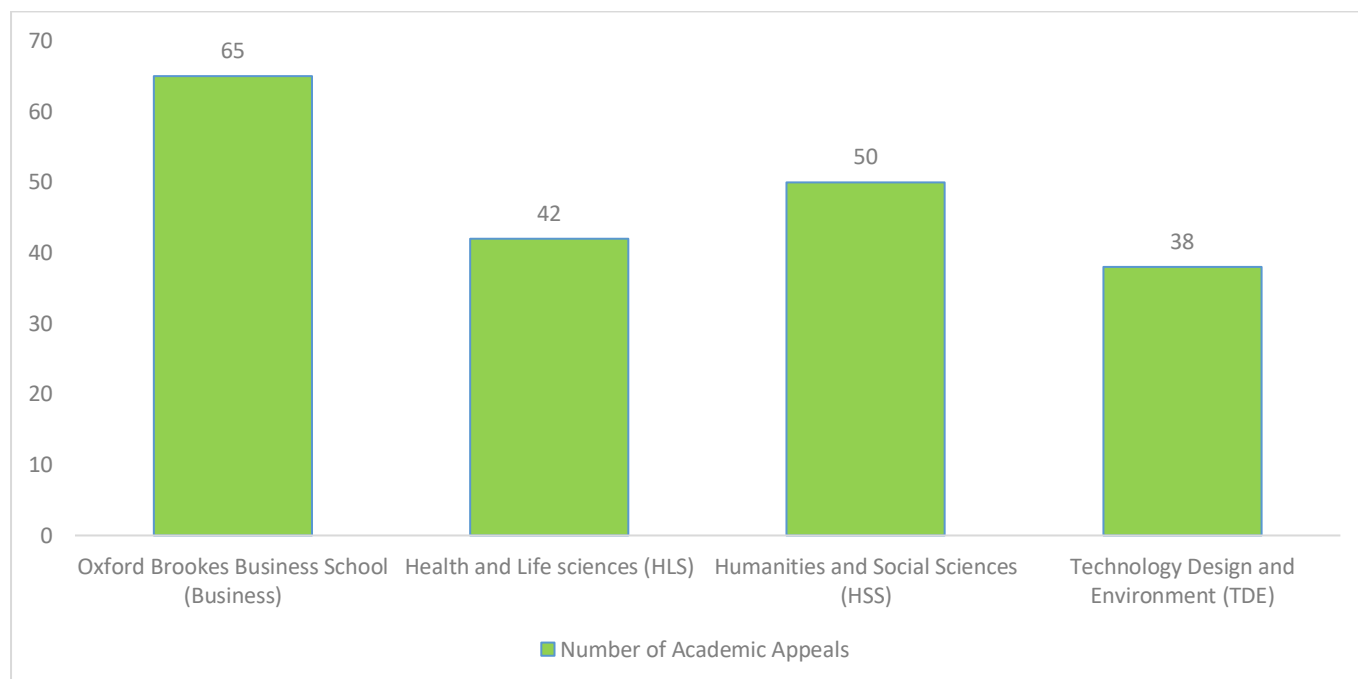


Chart 1 Total Appeals, by Faculty/Directorate 2019/20

This table shows how many appeals were requested at the first level, the number of requests to progress to subsequent levels of the procedure as well as outcomes across all levels

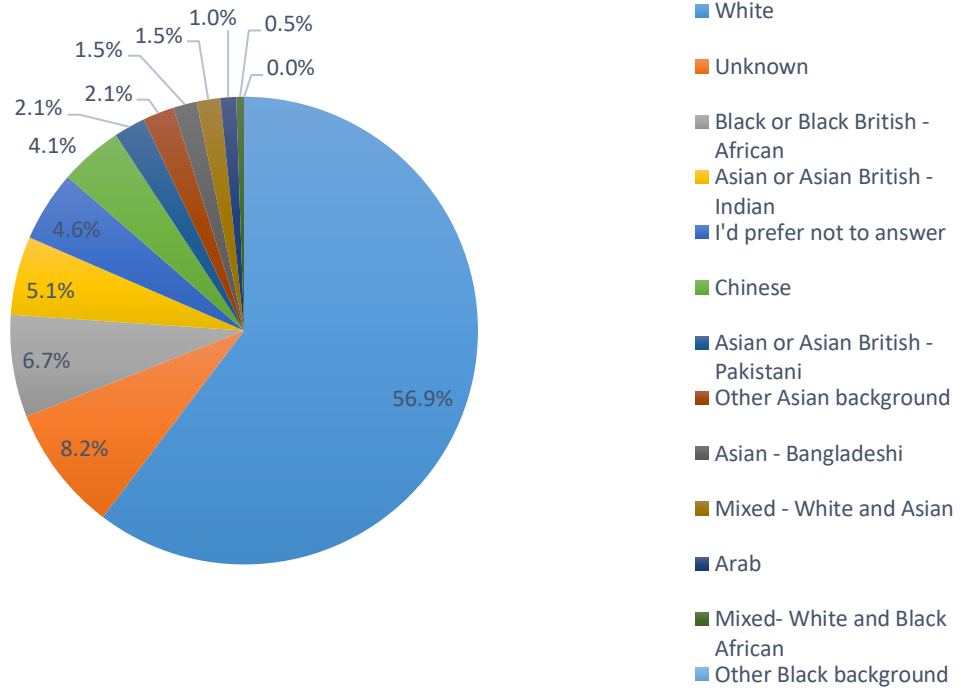

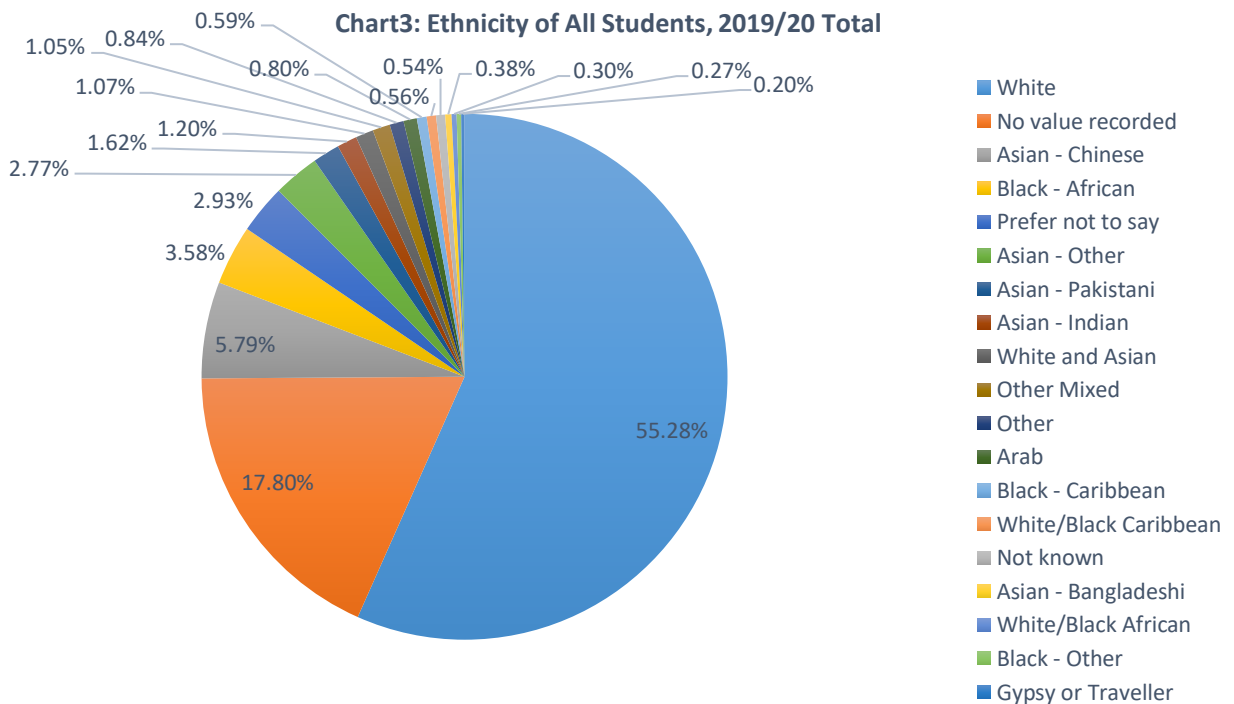

Chart 2: Ethnicity of students submitting Academic Appeals 2019/20



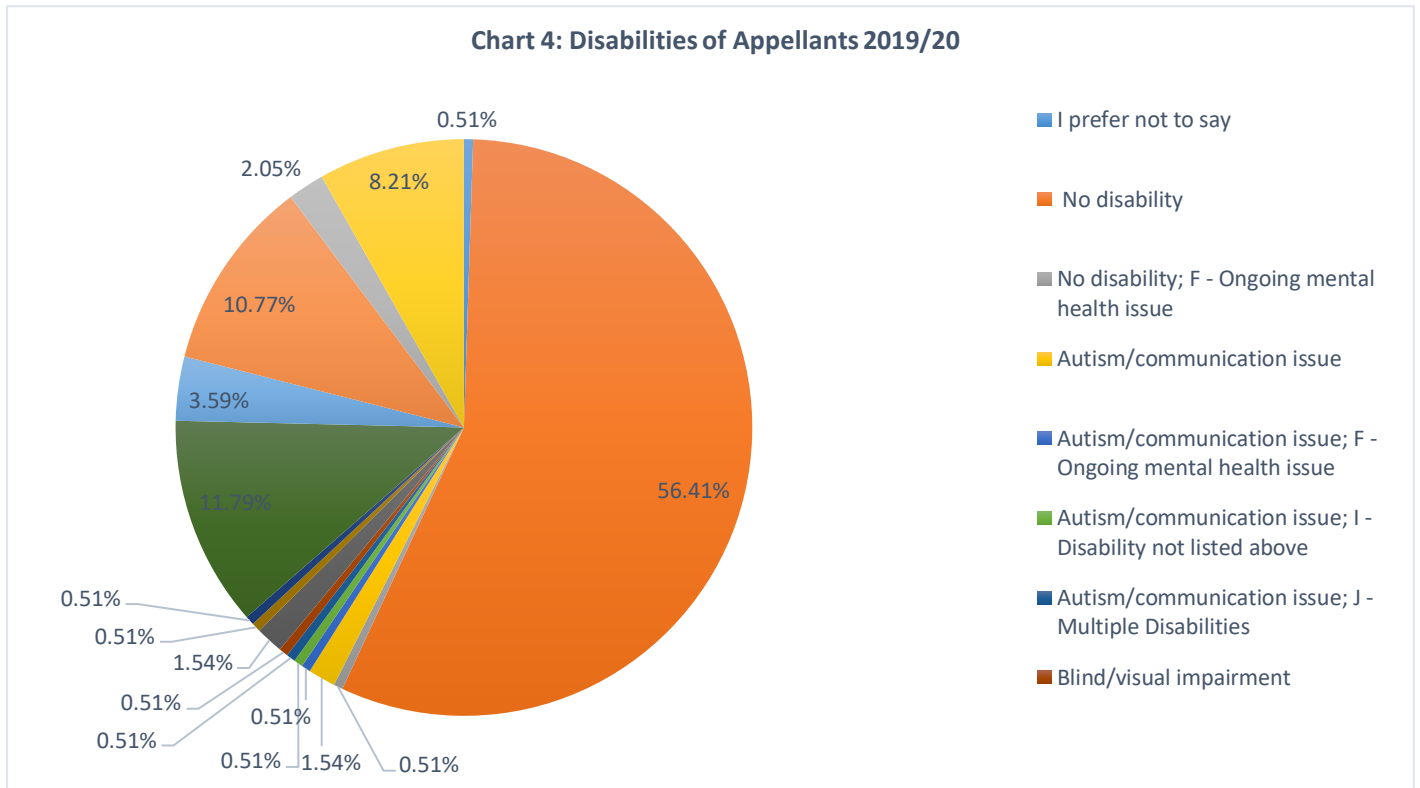
University Students' Ethnicity

Chart3: Ethnicity of All Students, 2019/20 Total

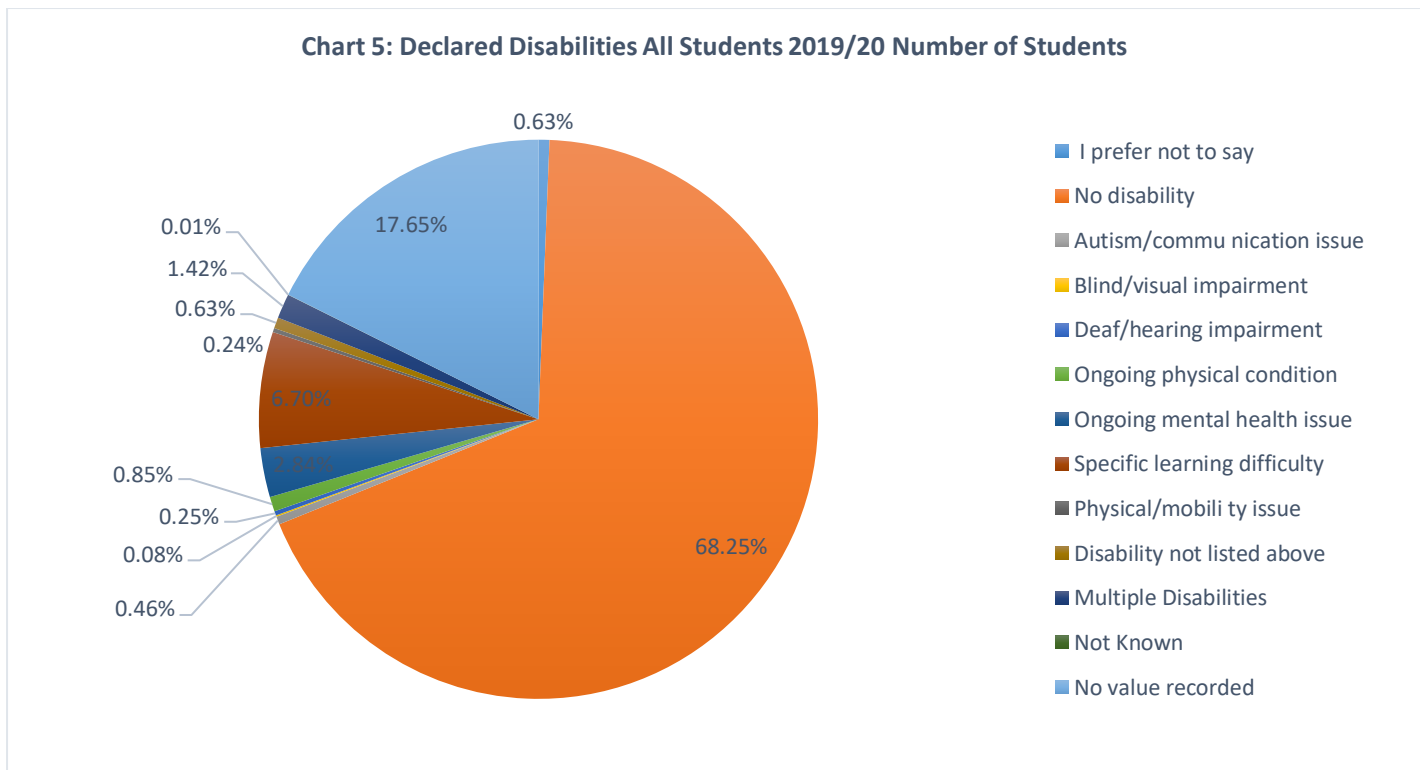
