Top tips to stay safe at uni

1. Register your valuables with Immobilise
2. Always lock doors and windows when leaving your property
3. Get your bike marked
4. Never leave valuables unattended on campus
5. Plan your journeys home on nights out
6. Never carry large quantities of cash
7. Never send money when requested via phone or email (even if it looks genuine)
8. Always report suspicious incidents to University Security Services

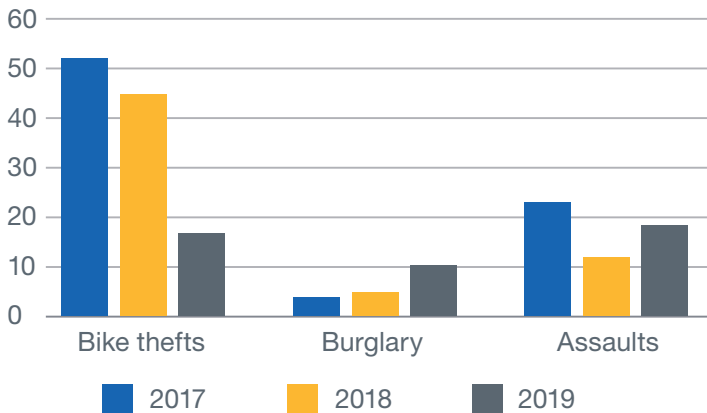

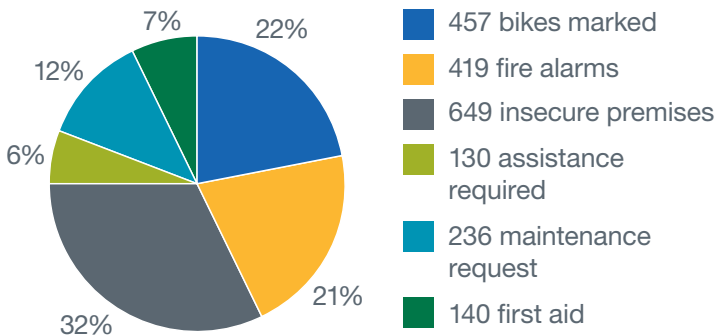

Personal safety

- Stay together: If you go out with a group of friends, stick together and look after one another.
- Be discreet: Avoid drawing attention to valuables and getting your phone out in public.
- Plan your journeys: How are you getting there? More importantly, how are you getting back?
- The right path: When walking to and from places, stick to busy routes- avoid poorly lit areas and alleyways.

Protect your Belongings

- Never leave items unattended, not even for a moment.
- Password-protect computers, tablets and mobile phones.

Accommodation Security

- Lock your door when you leave.
- Keep windows secured when you are out.
- Ensure valuable items are not left in view.
- Never let anyone in that you do not know.

Bike Security

- Use a D-Lock. Discounted D-Locks are available from Security Services.
- Lock both wheels and the frame to a cycle stand or another immovable object.
- Register your bike with www.bikeregister.com
