Preparing your application:

Before applying through the [Oxford Brookes online application system](#) please read through the notes below and gather the required supporting documents which will be submitted in the applicant portal.

It is possible to submit an application without having all the documents attached, and to add them later on. It is your responsibility to ensure that all documents are submitted, and your application may not be considered if the documents are not submitted by the deadline. You may wish to collate some documents into one document. It is also possible to email documents to hlsapplications@brookes.ac.uk if you are unable to upload them.

Required documents:

- Scanned copy of your passport.
- IELTS certificate or equivalent (if required)
- Scanned copies of your final degree certificates which have already been awarded
- Scanned copies of academic transcripts
- A full CV
- A document with the contact details (name, address, and organisation email address) for **two** referees who can be contacted if you are shortlisted. We will ask for your consent before writing to them. References should be provided from institutional email addresses. Before providing the referee details, please check that the contact details that you have for them are up to date.
