Update on Travel Survey Figures April 2017

1 Introduction

1.1 Background

- 1.1.1 Oxford Brookes developed and implemented its first University-wide Travel Plan in 1999, since then it has undertaken travel surveys to monitor effectiveness in 2002, 2004, 2006, 2007/8, 2009 and 2012.
- 1.1.2 Following the 2009 survey, the 2010-2015 Travel Plan was produced, encompassing all Oxford sites and superseding previous site-based Travel Plans.
- 1.1.3 In 2016 the Oxford Brookes University Interim Travel Plan 2016-2018 was produced.
- 1.1.4 In April 2017 the Travel survey was once again undertaken.

1.2 Aims and objectives of the 2012 travel survey

- 1.2.1 The principle aim was to identify changes that had occurred amongst both staff and students since previous surveys. The specific objectives were to understand:
 - Whether travel patterns and behaviour have changed
 - Priority areas that should be addressed as part of Travel Planning for each of the campuses
 - Where staff/students are travelling from; and
 - Which respondents might be willing/able to change to less environmentally-damaging or low-carbon alternatives (propensity to change)
- 1.2.2 Developing the survey questionnaire required a balance between ensuring results are directly comparable to previous surveys while reflecting the organisational changes at the University which have led to more cross-site working.
- 1.2.3 A target response rate was set at 10% for students and 30% for staff.

1.3 Purpose of this report

1.3.1 This report provides an overview of the survey methodology and key survey findings across all of the campuses, including aggregate University-wide results.

- 1.3.2 Separate survey reports have been produced which provide detailed findings for each site:
 - Headington Campus (comprising Headington Hill, the Gipsy Lane Site)
 - Marston Road
 - Wheatley
 - Harcourt Hill
 - Joel Joffe Campus (Swindon)
- 1.3.3 Figure 1 indicates the location of the campuses.

2 University-wide results

2.1.1 The results reported in this section represent the total for all responses across all sites at the University. While the total response was 1776, the following tables are based on all those who provided an answer.

Working hours

2.1.2 88.66% of students respondents are studying full time, this is also similar for staff as 71.79% of staff also work full time.

2.2 Travel to the campuses

2.2.1 Staff and students were asked to state which location was their main site / campus. 62.93% of staff stated their main site was Gipsy Lane/Headington Hill and 47.64% of students also selected this campus. Wheatley was the next most popular site, with 17.72% of staff and 21.66% of students stating this campus as their main site.




2.2.2 Respondents were asked to indicate their main method of travel to/from their main site, this has been analysed for both staff and students and the results are shown in the following diagrams:

2.2.3 The most commonly-cited mode of travel for staff is driving alone which accounts for 43% of staff. Cycling is the next most frequently mentioned at 17%, followed by walking with 10%. All car travel makes up approx. 50% of all main modes selected.





- 2.2.4 Around 19% students walk to their main campus, whilst 38% also use the BROOKESbus. 7% of students cycle and 19% drive alone.
- 2.2.5 Proportionally, students' use of sustainable travel modes is greater than that of staff.
- 2.2.6 Staff and students were then asked if any of the drop down reasons influenced their mode of travel. The answers were:




