



Study options

We can offer you a range of levels of study, from first and foundation degrees through to advanced study at master's and PhD level.

International Foundation: Our foundation courses provide a bridge between school study in your home country and undergraduate study, offering a guaranteed pathway to a degree if you pass with required grades.

Undergraduate: A bachelor's degree will take three years to complete full-time, or four years if you opt for a work placement.

Postgraduate: After completing your bachelor's degree, you can go on to study for a master's and specialise in an area that interests you.

Research degrees: You can study for a Master of Philosophy (MPhil) or Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) degree and conduct original research in your subject area.

Entry requirements vary depending on the course you are applying for. Equivalent academic qualifications can be accepted and we are happy to consider applicants on a case by case basis.

Scholarships

We offer a range of scholarships to help our international students with the costs of studying at Oxford Brookes. Financial support is available, such as student loans, grants and discount schemes, to help with tuition fees and living costs.
