VISION:

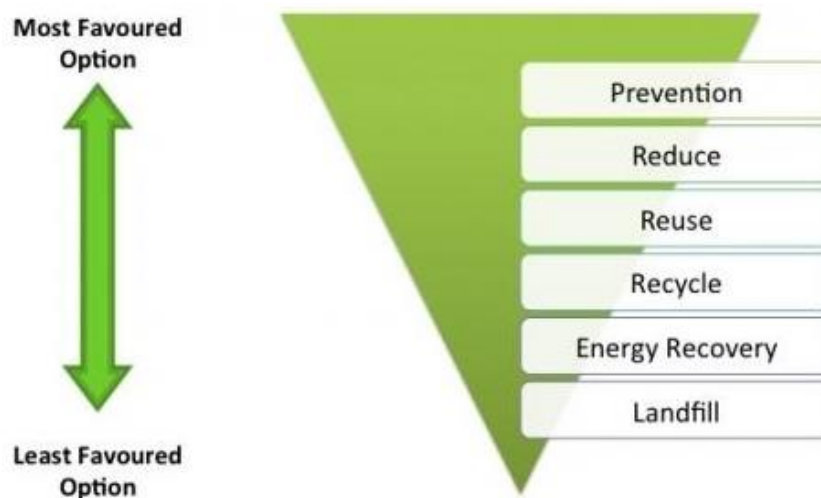
A culture of sustainable waste management across the organisation where principles of the waste hierarchy are integrated into every aspect of the University's processes and operations
