

Fees, funding and scholarships

Money shouldn't be a barrier to your success. At Oxford Brookes there are options available to support you in funding your studies. We offer <u>international scholarships</u> and other financial support to international students to help with tuition fees and living costs.

Tuition fees

How much will my course cost?

Fees for international students are set annually and the cost depends on the course you study. The tuition fee for one year's full-time undergraduate study in 2026-27 will be approximately £17,250 to £19,700. The tuition fee for one year's full-time postgraduate study in 2026-27 will be approximately £17,250 to £21,400.

Please note:

- Fees are quoted for full-time study unless specified otherwise.
- Quoted fees do not include the cost of a placement year. Please see our website for that information.
- Please be aware that some courses will involve some other additional costs that are not covered by your fees. Any additional costs are clearly explained on course webpages.

Paying your fees

Before your course starts you will receive information on how and when to pay your fees. For the majority of courses you can pay in two instalments.

Tuition fee deposits

If you are an international student, you will need to pay a minimum £3,000 deposit to secure your place at Oxford Brookes, or provide evidence of financial sponsorship by an Oxford Brookes-approved sponsor. Some applicants will be asked to pay a £5,000 top-up deposit before receiving their CAS (Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies). All deposit payments will be deducted from your tuition fees.

Study options

We can offer you a range of levels of study, from bachelor's and foundation degrees through to advanced study at master's and PhD level.

International Foundation

If you do not meet the minimum academic requirements for our undergraduate courses, you may still be able to apply for one of our international foundation courses. Please see <u>page 33</u> for details.

Undergraduate

A bachelor's degree will take three years to complete full-time, or four years if you opt for a work placement. You will need to have A-levels or the international equivalent.

Pre-Master's

If you do not meet the minimum academic requirements for our postgraduate courses, you may still be able to apply for one of our Pre-Master's programmes. Please see page 32 for details.

Postgraduate

After completing your bachelor's degree, you can go on to study for a master's and specialise in an area that interests you. The course will take one or two years to complete full-time. There are usually three stages to a master's degree: Postgraduate Certificate, Postgraduate Diploma and master's.

Research Degrees

Research at Oxford Brookes enjoys an international reputation, attracting high-quality staff and students as well as major funded projects. You can study for a Master of Philosophy (MPhil) or Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) degree and conduct original research in your subject area. As a research student at Brookes, you will join a vibrant and supportive environment, and benefit from expert supervision and a strong programme of research training.

Distance learning

Our distance learning options give you the flexibility to study for an Oxford Brookes degree level qualification from your home country. Some courses are only available through distance learning. Others include both distance learning and on-campus options, for example short study periods. Please check the details of the course you are interested in to see if it suits your needs.



Did you know, you can join us part-way through a degree programme?

Most of our courses consider applications for entry part-way through the course for students who have credit from previous learning or relevant professional experience. We even have a number of courses that have been specifically designed for students looking to join Oxford Brookes for the final year of their studies.

Oxford Brookes international pathways courses will help you to prepare for undergraduate or postgraduate study, and give you a great introduction to university life. You will be taught by highly qualified and experienced academic staff. They are specialists in English for Academic Purposes who have trained, taught and researched overseas and in the UK.

PRE-SESSIONAL ENGLISH

Our pre-sessional English courses help you meet the language requirements of your degree and can be combined with our foundation courses. Pre-sessional English is taught in 6-12 week blocks at different levels. You can take consecutive course blocks until you reach the level required for your degree course. The tables below show approximately how long you need to study depending on your current and required language level.

PRE-MASTER'S COURSES

If you do not meet the minimum academic requirements for our postgraduate courses, you may still be able to apply for one of our Pre-Master's programmes. These courses are designed to develop

your subject knowledge, study skills and academic language level in preparation for your master's degree. You can choose from one or two semesters depending on your needs.

- Study for one or two semesters (12-24 weeks) depending on your needs.
- Experience university life before your master's and gain confidence, especially if you have not studied for some time.
- Benefit from a discipline-specific pathway towards your master's subject.

INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION

If you do not meet the minimum academic requirements for our undergraduate courses, you may still be able to apply for one of our international foundation courses. Our foundation courses provide

a bridge between school study in your home country and undergraduate study, offering a guaranteed pathway to an undergraduate degree if you pass with required grades.

English language

If English is not your first language then you will need to show that your English language skills are at a high enough level to succeed in your studies. Your academic qualifications may show us this.

Entry requirements are expressed as an IELTS level (relating to the IELTS Academic version of the test). Most courses require at least IELTS 6.0, with no less than 5.5 in each skill. Some courses may have higher requirements, so please check the specific course page on our website. If you need a student visa, you must also meet the UK Visa and Immigration (UKVI) English language requirements.

Accept your offer

For direct applications, all information about your offer will be sent to you by our admissions team. You will need to reply directly to the University by the deadline given in order to accept your place.

For UCAS applications, once every university that you have applied to has made their decision, UCAS will ask you to choose your 'firm acceptance' (your first choice) and your 'insurance acceptance' (your second or backup choice).

You must make your decision by the deadline UCAS gives you, otherwise your offers will be declined automatically.

Pay your deposit

If you are an international student, you will need to pay a minimum £3,000 deposit to secure your place at Oxford Brookes, or provide evidence of financial sponsorship by an Oxford Brookes approved sponsor. Some applicants will be asked to pay a £5,000 top-up deposit before receiving their CAS. All deposit payments will be deducted from your tuition fees. Please check your offer letter for details.

Even if you have indicated the acceptance of your place through our portal or through UCAS, you will still need to pay your deposit in order to secure it.

Apply for accommodation

You will be able to apply for a place in our halls of residence once you have accepted your offer. You will be sent an email from our Accommodation Bureau, inviting you to apply.

Meet your conditions

Most applicants will receive a conditional offer. This means that we would like to offer you a place on your chosen

course, but we do not yet have sufficient information from you to confirm that place. Direct applicants can view the conditions of their offer in the application portal and in their offer letter. UCAS applicants need to check their UCAS Track portal to see the conditions of their offer.

Once you have met any of the conditions for your course, you should upload your evidence directly to your portal. UCAS applicants should send their proof to our admissions team at admissions@brookes.ac.uk.

When you have met all the conditions of your offer you will receive an unconditional offer and your place at Oxford Brookes University will be guaranteed.




